Dear Mr. Hannig,

This letter is in response to your request dated May 3, 2004, requesting amendment to NRC registration certificate NR-122-D-101-B. In reviewing the application, we find that it is lacking significant amounts of the required information. The following is the information your application did not provide:

1. A description of the changes being made to Model MK 1.0.
2. Prototype test results of the changed model, if necessary.
3. Confirmation that there have been no changes to the existing registration certificate and quality assurance program.

With incomplete documents and unavailability of adequate information the NRC Staff is unable to complete a safety evaluation of your device. Therefore, we have discontinued the review of your application. This is without prejudice to re-submission of your application. When you decided to re-submit your application for registration, please ensure that you have included the entire application with the mentioned sufficient information needed to allow NRC to evaluate your device.
