SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JUNE 2, 2004, MEETING WITH NEI TO DISCUSS

EMERGENCY PLANNING (EP) INSPECTIONS, TESTS, ANALYSES,

AND ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA (ITAAC)

On June 2, 2004, a meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and NEI at NRC Headquarters in Rockville, MD. Staff from the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency (DHS/FEMA) also participated in the meeting. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss EP ITAAC. A list of meeting attendees is included as Attachment 1. The meeting agenda is provided as Attachment 2.

NRC handouts were provided during the meeting. The handouts can be accessed through the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) under Accession No. ML041550392. Highlights of the Meeting

The meeting was a followup to a workshop held on April 27, 2004, on the same topic. A *Federal Register* notice (FRN) was issued to announce the April workshop and to solicit comments on the draft proposed EP ITAAC. NEI responded to the FRN in a May 27, 2004, letter (ADAMS Accession No. ML041540373). At the June 2, 2004, meeting NEI discussed their letter and the staff discussed proposed revisions to the draft EP ITAAC it had made based on verbal comments it had received at the April workshop. The staff's revised draft EP ITAAC are included in the NRC handouts mentioned above.

The main topics of discussion for the June meeting were the same as those discussed during the April workshop which were the role of risk information in the development of EP ITAAC and whether it is appropriate to have ITAAC associated with offsite actions. The staff and NEI agreed to (1) review each others comments and proposals. (2) develop revisions to their own

proposals to attempt to address the comments, and (3) discuss the issue again later in the summer.
