This refers to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission License (NRC) Number 29-01022-14, Docket 030-29741, our letter of May 21, 2004, and to the June 7, 2004 telephone conversation between your Ms. Judith A. Joustra and Mr. Barry J. Silber of our staff.

The following information is provided as requested in the June 7, 2004 telephone conversation:

Radiation Safety Officer (RSO): The RSO will receive training specific to all operational safety requirements as defined in the RSSDR, page 6. This training will be conducted by qualified instructors from SAIC, and/or their authorized representative.

Authorized Users: Certified operators, fully trained by the manufacturer or a qualified instructor, are required during operation of the device. Training will be consistent with the requirements specified in the RSSDR and Appendix G, NUREG 1556, Volume 4, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance about Fixed Gauge Licenses", dated October 1998. This training shall include emergency procedures to address shutter failures and environmental damage to the gauge.
