I am pleased to announce the appointment of C. William (Bill) Reamer as Deputy Director, Division of Waste Management, and Janet R. Schlueter as Chief, High-Level Waste Branch, Division of Waste Management (DWM), Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS).

Mr. Bill Reamer joined the NRC in 1976 as an attorney in the Office of the General Counsel (OGC). In 1981, he became the Legal Assistant to Chairman Nunzio J. Palladino, a position which he held until 1986. After a period of service outside the agency, Bill returned to the NRC's OGC in 1992. Since his return, he has held supervisory and management positions in OGC and NMSS, including Senior Supervisory Attorney for Nuclear Waste Management, OGC, and Chief, Engineering and Geosciences Branch; Chief, High-Level Waste and Performance Assessment Branch; and Chief, High-Level Waste Branch, NMSS.

Ms. Janet Schlueter joined the NRC in 1989 as a Health Physicist in the Medical and Academic Section, Division of Industrial and Medical Nuclear Safety, NMSS. From February 1989 through September 1995, she held positions of increasing responsibility as Health Physicist and Project Manager, and Section Leader through rotational assignments. From October 1995 through July 1996, Ms. Schlueter completed a rotational assignment as Materials Technical Assistant to the Deputy Executive Director for Nuclear Materials Safety, Safeguards and Operations Support in the Office of the Executive Director for Operations. In October 1996, Ms. Schlueter joined the permanent staff of Commissioner Edward McGaffigan, Jr. as Materials Technical Assistant where she was responsible for advising the Commissioner on the broad spectrum of materials related issues including High-Level Waste. Ms. Schlueter was designated as the Executive Assistant or Chief of Staff for the Commissioner in March 2000, while also continuing her responsibilities as Materials Technical Assistant, a dual position which she has held until now. Ms. Schlueter is a May 2001 graduate of the SES Candidate Development Program.

Prior to joining the NRC, Ms. Schlueter worked as a Health Physicist consultant and Radiation Protection Specialist to medical, academic and research facilities nationwide; a radiation therapy simulator operator; and a radiologic technologist.
