The subject task order expired on December 31, 2003. The NRC has paid ISL, Inc. \$68,371.42 and there is remaining fee of \$846.25. According to our records, there are funds remaining under this task order which are unexpended. Pending completion of all required closeout requirements, it is necessary to deobligate the excess funds for other immediate agency requirements.

Our records indicate that excess funds in the amount of \$11,257.33 exist under this task order. The purpose of this modification is to deobligate funds in the amount of \$11,257.33 thereby decreasing the amount obligated from \$80,475.00 to \$69,217.67.


All other terms and conditions of the subject task order remain the same.
