The subject task order expired on October 31, 2002. The NRC has paid ISL, Inc. \$31,484.97 and there is remaining fee of \$67.25. According to our records, there are funds remaining under this task order which are unexpended. Pending completion of all required closeout requirements, it is necessary to deobligate the excess funds for other immediate agency requirements.


