DEFERRAL OF TVA'S EXPECTED SUBMITTAL DATE FOR SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT (SQN) LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION

The purpose of this letter is to notify NRC of TVA's decision to defer the date upon which TVA plans to submit a License Renewal Application for SQN Units 1 and 2. By letter dated June 1, 2000, TVA provided NRC with advance notice of the anticipated schedules for submittal of license renewal applications for both Browns Ferry and Sequoyah Nuclear Plants. The letter also stated that TVA would keep NRC informed of any changes to the targeted schedule.

The letter indicated that the planned date for the SQN submittal was December 31, 2007. Though TVA still intends to seek SQN license renewal, TVA is deferring the date for submittal of the license renewal application. At present, no new submittal date has been established. TVA will inform NRC of its plans for license renewal application as soon as a new date is determined to assist NRC's resource planning process.
