## <u>ORDER</u>

Yesterday, we received a motion from the NRC Staff requesting that we stay the effect of an order the Licensing Board issued from the bench in this proceeding on June 25, 2004. The Staff has also submitted a petition for interlocutory review of the Board's order.

The Board found that the Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League's (BREDL) technical advisor has the necessary expertise to be given access to safeguards information and instructed the NRC Staff to give BREDL access to the safeguards information on Friday, July 2, 2004. Duke Energy Corporation supports the Staff's motion. BREDL does not oppose the motion for a temporary stay, but does oppose the motion for a stay pending interlocutory review of the Board's ruling.

To give Duke and BREDL a sufficient opportunity to respond to the Staff's two pleadings, we hereby issue a "housekeeping stay" of the Board's order until further order of the

Commission. Duke and BREDL should submit their responses to both Staff pleadings no later than Friday, July 9, 2004. BREDL shall have the option of submitting a reply (not to exceed five pages) to Duke's response by Tuesday, July 13, 2004.
