Throughout the process of our studies, investigations and findings, I have invited representatives from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) numerous times to come to an Environment Committee Meeting here at the Westchester County Board of Legislators to discuss Indian Point, but to no avail.

As we move forward with new issues before us, such as spent fuel storage and the relicensing of IP2 and 3, I would like to officially invite you or your representative to meet with us. Recently, I had a chance to meet your Region I Regional Administrator Hub Miller at a public hearing in Peekskill, New York.
