002/102 - one background set should remain, this one probably has the least interference with the airport

005/105 - for construction on the mill site, it is important to be able to characterize the groundwater for construction dewatering

186/187 - intermediate and deep zone wells at the periphery of the plume - needed to bracket the plume boundary

125, 135, 181 - If the flood irrigation practices in the hay meadow change, the stratification of the plume may change. Therefore, some of the shallow wells should remain.
