
DUKE ENERGY CORPORATION'S RESPONSE TO THE "NRC STAFF'S FIRST

In accordance with the schedule established by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Licensing Board") in its April 28, 2004 "Order (Setting Schedule for Discovery and Hearing on Security-Related Matters)," Duke Energy Corporation ("Duke") hereby files its Response to the June 21, 2004 "NRC Staff's First Set of Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents to Duke Energy Corporation on the Admitted Security Contention" ("NRC Staff Discovery Request").
