Dear Mr. Von Till:

We are responding to your June 10, 2004 letter in which the NRC Staff has asked for a re-baselined reclamation cost estimate using a format similar to NUREG-1620, Rev.1. To accomplish this task UNC plans to retain MACTEC for assistance, and by this letter UNC is requesting a six week extension to prepare the revised estimate. This time is needed so that we can compile all of the relevant background information for MACTEC, and so that they can reconstruct the long history of progress following the initial reclamation cost estimates.

UNC will endeavor to complete the revision earlier than six weeks, but in any event, is comfortable that the revised estimate can be submitted by August 20, 2004. As of September 1997 United Nuclear Corporation became a wholly-owned, indirect subsidiary of General Electric Company. GE Corporate Environmental Programs has been retained through a separate administrative services agreement to assist United Nuclear both technically and administratively with environmental issues at the Church Rock site.
