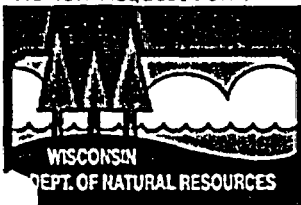

Status: State Endangered, Federally Threatened.

Habitat: Fasset's Locoweed prefers shores of sandy lakes and flowers from mid-May
