my first experience with Atomic energy was Sept, 1945 in Nagasaki, Japan. after 3 1/2 months there we moved on to other sites. On Oct 27-1969 I joined Wisc Elec at Point Beach - maintenance dept. Being there early on I saw the construction & completion of Unit 1. Unit 2 was under way. We fired up Unit 1 with a total complement of 85 people. I see it now has 700. Does the tail wag the dog?

I retired in 1987 after 18 yrs. The construction of Point Beach was always being improved. Personnel were dedicated. Training was always in process. I'm sure the mechanical components are inspected at each overhaul as they were when I was there.

I see no reason not to extend the license of Unit One & Unit Two at Point Beach. The Site is a beautiful addition to the electrical grid which serves our nation.
