In conformance with the Commission's policy on notification of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (ASLB) of new, relevant, and material information, this memorandum provides the information discussed below.

The attached Notice of Opportunity to Comment and Proposed No Significant Hazards Consideration Determination was issued on July 1, 2004, by the staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission regarding the proposed use of mixed oxide lead test assemblies at one of the two units of the Catawba Nuclear Power Station. It was published in the *Federal Register* on July 12, 2004 (69 FR 41852).
