The policy, as revised, states "Additionally, licensees who plan to comply with 20 CFR 50.48(c) may have existing identified noncompliances which could reasonable be corrected under 20 CFR 50.48(c)." This is incorrect. The correct reference is 10 CFR 50.48(c). It also appears that the word "reasonable" should be changed to "reasonably."
