The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff and representatives of TVA (the applicant) held a telephone conference call on April 28, 2004, regarding the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant Units 1, 2 and 3 (BFN) license renewal application. The participants discussed the schedule for the NRC's audit of the applicant's aging management reviews and programs for consistency with the NUREG 1801, Generic Aging, Lessons Learned (GALL) Report and/or previously approved staff positions. This schedule was included in the BFN license renewal application review schedule that was transmitted to the applicant on March 31, 2004.

The NRC staff provided clarifications on the timing and duration of the proposed audits. No staff decisions were made during the telephone conference call.
