SUBJECT: REVISION OF MANAGEMENT DIRECTIVE (MD) 9.9

This memorandum summarizes several telephone conversations between Sarah Wigginton of my staff and Stan Schofer of your staff regarding the revision of MD 9.9, "Organization and Functions, Office of the Licensing Support System Administrator."

As Ms. Wigginton explained, each MD in the Volume 9 series addresses an individual office and its components in a single issuance. Thus, MD 9.9 became defunct when the LSS function transferred to IRM. Because the LSS is now a component of IRM, it should be discussed in MD 9.22, "Organization and Functions, Office of Information Resources Management; however, as you may know, MD 9.22 has not been revised since the dissolution of the former Office of Administration and Resources Management.

Volume 9 of the MD system is currently undergoing a review by the Office of Personnel (OP) with the objective of consolidating all of the delegations of authority into one document. Whether this concept will be implemented is still undecided; however, we are deferring action on individual MDs until we can produce a prototype document for review and comment by offices, committees, boards, and the regions. OP anticipates a draft of this directive being available by the end of CY 1995.

In the meantime, OP issued NUREG-0325, Revision 18, on July 23, 1995. OP anticipates that this document will become the handbook for the new Volume 9 MD. NUREG-0325 describes the LSS and includes functions of the LSSA's staff.

The RRDB staff recommends that you postpone action on MD 9.9 because we do not issue separate MDs for individual components of an office and there is no IRM-wide MD in Volume 9 to which information regarding the LSSA can be added.
