SUMMARY OF INFORMATION COLLECTION REQUEST

Title: 10 CFR Part 4, Nondiscrimination in Federally Assisted Commission Programs (Final OCP)

Current Burden/Responses: 352 hours/128 responses

Proposed Burden/Responses: 432 hours/108 responses (54 responses + 54 recordkeepers)

Frequency of Response: On occasion and annually

Number of Respondents: 54

Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses: The overall burden increased from 352 hours to 432 hours due to an increase in the number of respondents from 32 to 54. The number of respondents was incorrectly captured as Agreement States only and should have included the educational institutions (+6) and other non-profit organizations (+15) that were inadvertently not included. The number of Agreement States increased by 1 from 32 to 33. Although the number of respondents increased, the number of responses decreased because the reporting frequency decreased from quarterly to annually and the burden was adjusted accordingly. The reporting frequency was reduced because the NRC has limited resources to review the reports. Also, the cost for professional staff-hours increased from \$143/hr to \$156/hr in accordance with Part 170.
