Request for change in designation of Radiation Safety Officer

This letter is to request that Mr. Luke Trauger be designated as the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for License # 37-30804-02 and have signature authority for NRC related items on behalf of CFC Logistics. We request that the NRC review Mr. Trauger's credentials and notify CFC Logistics if he is acceptable to the NRC for the position as RSO. Until the NRC has made that determination, Mr. Russell Stein will continue his responsibilities as the current RSO.

As of July 12, 2004, Mr. Trauger has successfully completed his training with Mr. Stein on the GRAY*STAR Irradiator and the transition of RSO responsibilities specific to our operation.

Mr. Trauger has worked in Irradiator operations and engineering for more than ten years as well as holding the position of RSO. Mr. Trauger experienced multiple NRC inspections and has never been issued a violation or observation. His professional training includes Irradiator Safety, Irradiator Operations and Radiation Safety Officer. His formal education includes a Masters degree in Technology Management from Stevens Institute of Technology and a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from Lafayette College.

The current CFC Logistics organization structure will remain unchanged with the transition from Mr. Stein to Mr. Trauger. Mr. Trauger will be given full authority to stop any potential unsafe operation of the irradiator.
