The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is evaluating its regulations pertaining to general licensees operating under 10 CFR 40.22 and the possible need for distribution requirements for source material distributed to these general licensees.

Per our discussion on July 20, 2004, I am requesting that you provide copies of your records pertaining to the transfer of source material that CERAC Inc. made to known general licensees. If available, please include information regarding to whom the transfers were made, contact information, and form and quantity of source material transferred. In our discussion, you stated that you may not be able to easily provide transfer information for the last 5 years because your electronic system has only been operational for the past few years. As such, please provide the information you have available through the onset of your electronic tracking system. Additionally, if you are aware of any competitors or other companies distributing source material to general licensees, I would appreciate you providing me the names of those companies.
