RESOLUTION SUPPORTING POINT BEACH NUCLEAR POWER PLANT LICENSE RENEWAL

TO THE MANITOWOC COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

1	WHEREAS, Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant became operational with the start-up of Unit 1
2	in December 1970 and Unit 2 became operational in March 1972; and
4	WHEREAS, Point Beach has operated safely and efficiently for over 30 years, generated a
5	record 8.1 million megawatt hours of electricity in 2003, and its 1036 megawatts of electrical
6 7	generating capacity remain vital to Wisconsin's economy; and
8	WHEREAS, Wisconsin Energy Corporation has continually reinvested in the Point Beach
9	facility to assure the continued safe, efficient, and economical production of electricity for
10	Wisconsin's homes, businesses, and factories; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, the 700 permanent jobs at Point Beach and the extensive use of contractors for
13	ongoing maintenance and special projects are recognized as vitally important to the economy of
14 15	Manitowoc County and Northeast Wisconsin; and
16	WHEREAS, Wisconsin Energy Corporation announced in December 2003 that it intended to
17	renew the license of both units at Point Beach for an additional twenty years; and

19	WHEREAS, Nuclear Management Company, which operates the Point Beach Nuclear Plant
20	for Wisconsin Energy Corporation, submitted a license renewal application for both units at the
21	Point Beach Nuclear Plant to the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission on February 25,
22	2004; and

24	WHEREAS, the Nuclear Regulatory Agency is the Federal agency charged with oversight of
25	our nation's nuclear facilities and encourages public input and comment on license renewal
26	proceedings; and

28	WHEREAS, the Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant has been a good neighbor to the
29	communities within Manitowoc County for over three decades;

31	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Manitowoc County Board of Supervisors
32	supports the renewal of the licenses for the nuclear generation facilities at Point Beach, to assure
33	their continued operation as a safe, economical, and integrally important component of Wisconsin's
34	electric power supply system for another 20 years; and
