Dear Mr. Cox:

The staff has reviewed your letter dated March 29, 2004, and has determined that it does not contain enough detailed information for the staff to make a determination that the surety is adequate. Appendix C to NUREG-1620, Rev.1, "Standard Review Plan for the Review of Reclamation Plans for Mill Tailings Sites Under Title II of the Uranium Mill Tailings Radiation Control Act of 1978," identifies the information that should be provided for surety cost estimates. It states that information including quantities, unit costs, estimates and assumptions should be included for the surety updating process. Although unit cost estimates have been provided, the basis for these estimates was not included. Therefore, we request the following additional information:

- 1. Provide the basis for unit cost estimates. For example, provide specifics for the unit cost of "new tailings well" (page 1 of 4, Unit Costs Section).
- 2. Provide specifications of collection wellheads, valves, meters, and pumps.
- 3. If third party estimates have been used as a basis, please provide a copy of the cost estimates.
- 4. Provide information about the site regarding quantities of items to reclaim. Topographic maps can be used to delineate areas to be reclaimed and to identify special features (wells, etc.).

Please submit your revised estimate within 30 days of the date of this letter or provide an alternate schedule for doing so. With this letter we have closed our tracking number TAC LU0037 and will open a new one when we receive your response.
