### MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Reflecting Status Conference)

At the conclusion of yesterday's status conference call, and as will be fully reflected in the Transcript thereof, the Presiding Officer and counsel for the parties agreed that the following key actions were appropriate to take: (1) counsel for Petitioners/Intervenors would in the next few days <u>supplement and update</u>, in the manner discussed, his previously-filed report of the responses received from his clients (regarding an inquiry made at our behest about their continuing interest in pursuing the litigation); and (2) the Presiding Officer (a) <u>would request that Settlement Judge Abramson</u>, in consultation with those involved in the continuing settlement negotiations, establish a deadline for them to bring those negotiations to a <u>conclusion</u> and (b) could thereupon continue to hold the underlying litigation in abeyance until the expiration of the deadline so established by Judge Abramson.

Other matters discussed in the call will be handled at the appropriate time in the manner there indicated. Through electronic transmission of this document to him, Judge Abramson will be deemed formally notified of this request that he establish a settlement deadline.

It is so ORDERED.
