Pursuant to the requirements of License SMB-911, Conditions 37a, 50, 51 and 52, FMRI submits the enclosed information. In addition to satisfying the above referenced license conditions, information supplied should serve to further define the implementation of Phase I decommissioning activities per FMRI's Approved Decommissioning Plan (ADP). In particular, chapters 8, 9, 10 and 11 have been referenced in order to furnish the enclosed information.


As you are aware, per my letter to the NRC dated March 04, 2004, the contractor selection process for Phase I was delayed pending the completion of the NRC hearing process. As such, all elements of the requirements for implementation are covered in the included information. As previously agreed by FMRI and the NRC, aspects that may inherently be "contractor specific" will be supplemented at the time final contractor selection is completed, but prior to the beginning of any Phase I physical decommissioning activity.

Additionally, it is anticipated a license amendment request (reference letter from the NRC's Daniel Gillen dated July 12, 2004) will be forthcoming to address elements of License SMB-911 Condition 10 that were also affected by the delay associated with the completion of the NRC hearing process.
