Here are responses to the questions you had about Clinton Lake. I apologize for the delay in responding, Craig has been on vacation since last week.

Q: Who owns Clinton Lake?

A: The 5,000-acre cooling lake is owned by AmerGen Energy Company, LLC.

Q: Are there any agreements with Local, State, or Federal agencies concerning the use and care of the lake?

A: The Illinois Department of Natural Resources, under a lease agreement with AmerGen, manages the recreational facilities around the Clinton Power Station, which includes Clinton Lake.

Q: When the lake was closed after Sept. 11, 2001, who required the closure?

A: A joint agreement to close the lake shortly after the Sept. 11 terrorist attack was made by AmerGen, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, and the Illinois Department of Nuclear Safety. This cooperative agreement enabled us to review our existing security plans to make whatever changes were necessary to deal with the newly-faced security threat to our nation. With respect to overall safety at the plant, we continue to enhance our security measures and have an on-going communication line between local,
