We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region V final exercise report (ADAMS Accession No. ML042180127), dated June 21, 2004, for the March 23, 2004 plume exposure pathway exercise at the Fermi 2 Nuclear Power Plant.

Two areas requiring corrective action were identified by FEMA Region V staff regarding the performance of Michigan officials.

We fully recognize that any corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.
