The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received an early site permit (ESP) application, dated September 25, 2003, from Dominion Nuclear North Anna, LLC. The application asks the NRC to consider whether the North Anna site would be suitable for the future construction of up to two new nuclear units. The applicant is not requesting approval to actually build the units. The NRC's ESP review process was discussed at a public meeting in the Louisa County Library on April 1, 2003, at the Lake Anna Civic Association annual meeting on July 26, 2003, and at a public scoping meeting for the environmental review at the Louisa County Middle School on December 8, 2003.

The application is available through the NRC's web page ([www.nrc.gov](http://www.nrc.gov)) and at the Louisa County Library, 881 Davis Highway, Mineral, Virginia. The web page location for the application is <http://www.nrc.gov/reactors/new-licensing/license-reviews/esp/north-anna.html>.

The NRC is currently developing a draft safety evaluation report (focusing on site safety issues) and a draft environmental impact statement (focusing on environmental issues). The staff plans to publish draft environmental impact statement in October 2004 and the draft safety evaluation report in December 2004.
