Dear Mr. Loux:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your letter dated August 9, 2004, concerning the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) proposal for processing NRC staff requests for additional information concerning key technical issue (KTI) agreements.

The NRC staff expects that DOE will address all the 293 agreements before submitting the license application (LA) to the staff. We note that DOE has submitted responses to 286 agreements, and has assured the NRC staff that it will respond to the remaining agreements by September 2004. We expect the staff will provide feedback to DOE concerning the KTI agreement responses; it will be up to DOE to decide how, or whether, to respond to the staff's feedback. The staff will continue its pre-licensing consultations with DOE before DOE's submittal of the LA, and will focus its remaining pre-licensing activities on areas most significant to repository performance.

The pre-licensing consultation phase has been intended to provide DOE with an understanding of the information expected in an LA. The pre-licensing phase has used various mechanisms (such as identifying KTIs, establishing KTI agreements, holding technical exchanges and public meetings) to help the NRC staff identify potential licensing issues. When DOE files an LA, the pre-licensing phase, along with the KTI resolution process, will end, and the KTIs and the related agreements will no longer be the focus of NRC staff attention. Indeed, some KTIs will likely remain unresolved at the end of the pre-licensing phase. From then onward, NRC will evaluate whether the application adequately addresses NRC regulations. Consequently, requirements contained in 10 CFR Part 63, and not the KTI process, will provide the basis for a licensing determination.
