

**Report for Period of January 1, 2004 through June 30, 2004**

**TEST RESULTS**

Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC) performs random testing of the workforce at an annual rate of at least 50 percent in accordance with 10 CFR 26.24(a)(2). For the six-month period beginning January 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2004 random screens were performed at a rate of 25.08% of the WCNOC population.

WCNOC submitted blind performance specimens in accordance with 10 CFR 26, Appendix A, Section 2.8(e)(2), requirements. There were no reportable events.

**WCNOC Employees**

During this reporting period, one WCNOC employee tested positive for alcohol during a for-cause test. The individual's unescorted access was suspended. Unescorted access was reinstated after the individual completed the requirements of 10 CFR 26 and WCNOC procedures. Based on the evaluation by the contracted psychologist, the individual was not placed in the follow-up program.

One WCNOC employee could not provide an adequate breath sample during a random screen. A medical evaluation performed by the Medical Review Officer (MRO) determined a medical problem existed which prevented the individual from providing an adequate breath sample. The individual was excused from the breath testing per the MRO's recommendation.

**Contractors**

No contractors tested positive for drugs or alcohol during this reporting period.

**Summary of Management Actions**

**Fitness For Duty Program Changes**

Internal audit K-608, "Access Authorization/Fitness For Duty/Personnel Access Data System," conducted during this time period, identified several recommendations for enhancements. The recommendations were evaluated and incorporated into the Fitness For Duty program.

During this reporting period, no licensed operator or supervisor tested positive, and no significant FFD event reports were made.
