Withdrawal of Request for Temporary Relaxation of Security Force Overtime Limit

Reference: Turkey Point Letter L-2004-137 dated June 23, 2004, "Request for Temporary Relaxation of Security Force Overtime Limit"

In the referenced letter, Florida Power & Light (FPL) requested a temporary relaxation from the 48-hour group average weekly work hour limit (averaged over consecutive six-week periods) in Order 03-038 for the six-week period ending August 22, 2004. The request was based on past experience with security force attrition and conservative projections of overtime use. While recent projections estimated that the 48-hour limit would be exceeded for the above period, current projections indicate that security force overtime will closely approach the 48-hour limit but will not exceed it. The projection is still conservative in that it assumes a certain degree of attrition.

The training of additional personnel to support security activities outside the protected area will be completed in early August. This will allow protected area qualified personnel to be deployed from owner-controlled area duties to protected area duties and assist in keeping security force overtime within the 48-hour limit. This is one of the measures FPL has taken, as described in the referenced letter, to ensure compliance to Order 03-038.

As a result of FPL's actions in response to Order 03-038, as described above, FPL no longer believes that a relaxation of Order requirements is needed and herewith withdraws the request made in the referenced letter.
