The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission intends to publish a final rule, in the Federal

Register, that will amend its regulation in 10 CFR Part 35, "Medical Use of Byproduct Material".

This rulemaking will extend the expiration date for the training and experience requirements for

radiation safety officers, authorized medical physicists, authorized nuclear pharmacists, and

authorized users (Subpart J) for 1 year, from October 24, 2004, to October 24, 2005. The

rulemaking will allow sufficient time for implementation of the forthcoming final rule, which

amends the training and experience requirements, including new requirements for the

recognition of certain specialty board certifications.
