for MEPROLIGHT Tritium Illuminated Watches and Gages

Dear Mr. Jankovich,

We respectfully request that Device Registration Certificate NR-1119-D-102-E be transferred to inactive status. In keeping with the instructions of Paragraph 13.4 NUREG-1556, Volume 3, the following information is provided:

The total number of products sold and still in use is approximately 500 watches.

Services to be provided have not changed. The same distribution network was used for both watches and weapon sights. Since the weapon sight business is still active, we can offer the same service as was previously supplied. Any watch requiring repair will be sent by the distributor to Meprolight, Inc who will forward it to the manufacturer (Meprolight Ltd) for repair. In the unlikely event that a source will need replacement, there is no problem of availability since the manufacturer (mb microtec) is in constant production of these sources for our overseas use as well as for other watch manufacturers.

We hereby commit that Meprolight will no longer commercially distribute devices covered by this registration certificate.

Meprolight certifies that no changes have been made to the watches since their initial registration.
