Mr. Goss,

First, thank you for meeting with John Jaksch and me last Friday. The information you provided to us will be very helpful as we evaluate the early site permit application.

During the meeting you asked whether information related to evacuation in the event of an emergency was available to the public. I confirmed that the Dominion web site has a lot of good information on it for local residents. The information includes explanations of how responsibilities are divided between the licensee, State and FEMA, how to be prepared, and evacuation routes with assembly locations. In addition, I believe that Dominion mails information to residents within a certain radius of the plant on a periodic (annual?) basis. I'm trying to confirm that and will let you know when I find out.

Mr. Goss,

As a follow-up to my earlier e-mail. I talked to Tony Banks, the environmental PM at Dominion, regarding dissemination of information about the evacuation plan. He said they don't mail information directly to residents. Rather, they send a large number of copies to the affected counties - directing them to the county administrators, directors of emergency services, and the school systems. So residents can either get the plan from the Dominion web page or through their county government.

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
