Here is the information Kaz Campe sent me in preparation for the previously scheduled site visit:

The main thing is to have someone available who is familiar with Section 2.2 of the CPS Site Safety Analysis Report. Topics for discussion include:

**Pipelines (locations on map)
Transportation (air, rail, and highway traffic)
Industrial facilities**

There may be a question or two relating to plant systems (control room ventilation stuff) and structures (blast overpressure capacity), but I do not expect them to require detailed coverage.

I anticipate the opportunity to have a brief tour of the site and its vicinity to get a first hand visualization of key items of interest (e.g., highways, railways, pipelines, airports, industrial facilities).

Hope this helps.
