
Supplemental Response to the April 29, 2003, Orders – Supplemental RAI Follow-up
Response to June 17, 2004 and June 30, 2004 Requests for Additional Information

On June 17, 2004, and on June 30, 2004, the NRC issued requests for additional information (RAI) regarding Florida Power & Light (FPL) letter L-2004-107 dated April 28, 2004, (Supplemental Response to the April 29, 2003 Orders (EA-03-086)). FPL and FPL Energy Seabrook, LLC responded to those requests in letters L-2004-153 and L-2004-162, dated July 7, 2004 and July 14, 2004, respectively. Based upon subsequent resolution of certain items identified in our July 7, 2004 and July 14, 2004 submittals, FPL and FPL Energy Seabrook, LLC provide the enclosed supplemental RAI follow-up information.
