Subject: Dewatering Structure Usage for Schuylkill River Debris Removal

Dear Ms. Fields:

As part of LGS Outfall 001 discharge diffuser routine maintenance, Schuylkill River debris removal activities are currently being planned. The debris, consisting primarily of river stone, has been sampled and meets existing Safe Fill Policy parameters. It will be deposited in the Schuylkill River Pump House settling basin, which is currently permitted for dewatering pump house intake structure silt. Ultimately, the solid material will be transported to an upland disposal site, or shipped to a permitted landfill.

Limerick Generating Station is requesting permission to use Outfall 012, which is fed from the settling basin, for discharging river water from the debris removal process. For this outfall, the subject permit requires daily estimated flows, and analyses for oil and grease, total suspended solids, total and dissolved iron, and pH. Samples will be obtained each day that discharges occur through Outfall 012.
