



SUBJECT: RULEMAKING PLAN - REVISION OF DOSE LIMIT FOR MEMBERS OF THE
PUBLIC EXPOSED TO HOSPITALIZED PATIENTS (PART 20)

The Office of Information Resources Management (IRM) has reviewed the subject rulemaking plan and concurs in it. Although you indicate the preferred Alternative 3 will not require reporting or recordkeeping, your discussion under "Preferred Option" suggests that it will impose additional recordkeeping requirements. Accordingly, please modify the "Coordination" statement in the Commission Paper to include the Office of Chief Information Officer concurrence as follows: "The Office of Chief Information Officer has reviewed the rulemaking plan for information technology and information management implications and concurs in it. However, the plan suggests new information collection requirements that must be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget prior to publication of the proposed rule." Under "Supporting Documents Needed," indicate that an OMB clearance package will be prepared for this rulemaking. Under "Schedule," indicate that the OMB clearance package will be submitted to OMB at the same time the proposed rule will be published in the Federal Register.
