By letter dated July 13, 2004, Framatome ANP submitted for NRC staff review Topical Report BAW-10252, Revision 0, "Analysis of Containment Response to Postulated Pipe Ruptures Using GOTHIC." The NRC staff has performed an acceptance review of BAW-10252. We have found that the material presented is sufficient to begin our comprehensive review. The staff expects to issue requests for additional information by February 25, 2005, and complete its review by July 29, 2005, and estimates that the review will require approximately 500 staff hours including project management time. The review schedule milestones and estimated review costs were discussed and agreed upon in a telephone conference between Gayle Elliot and myself on August 26, 2004.
