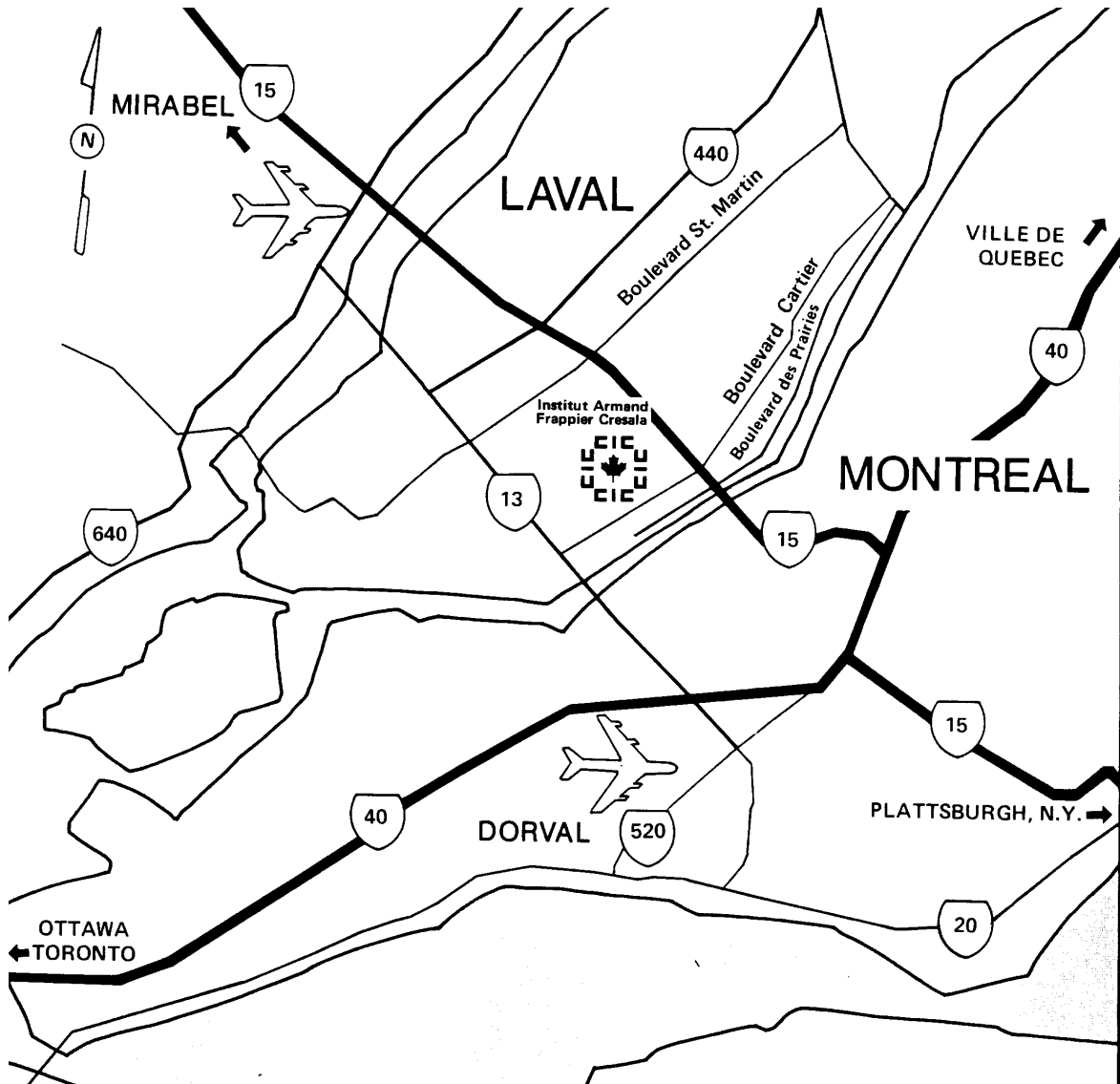

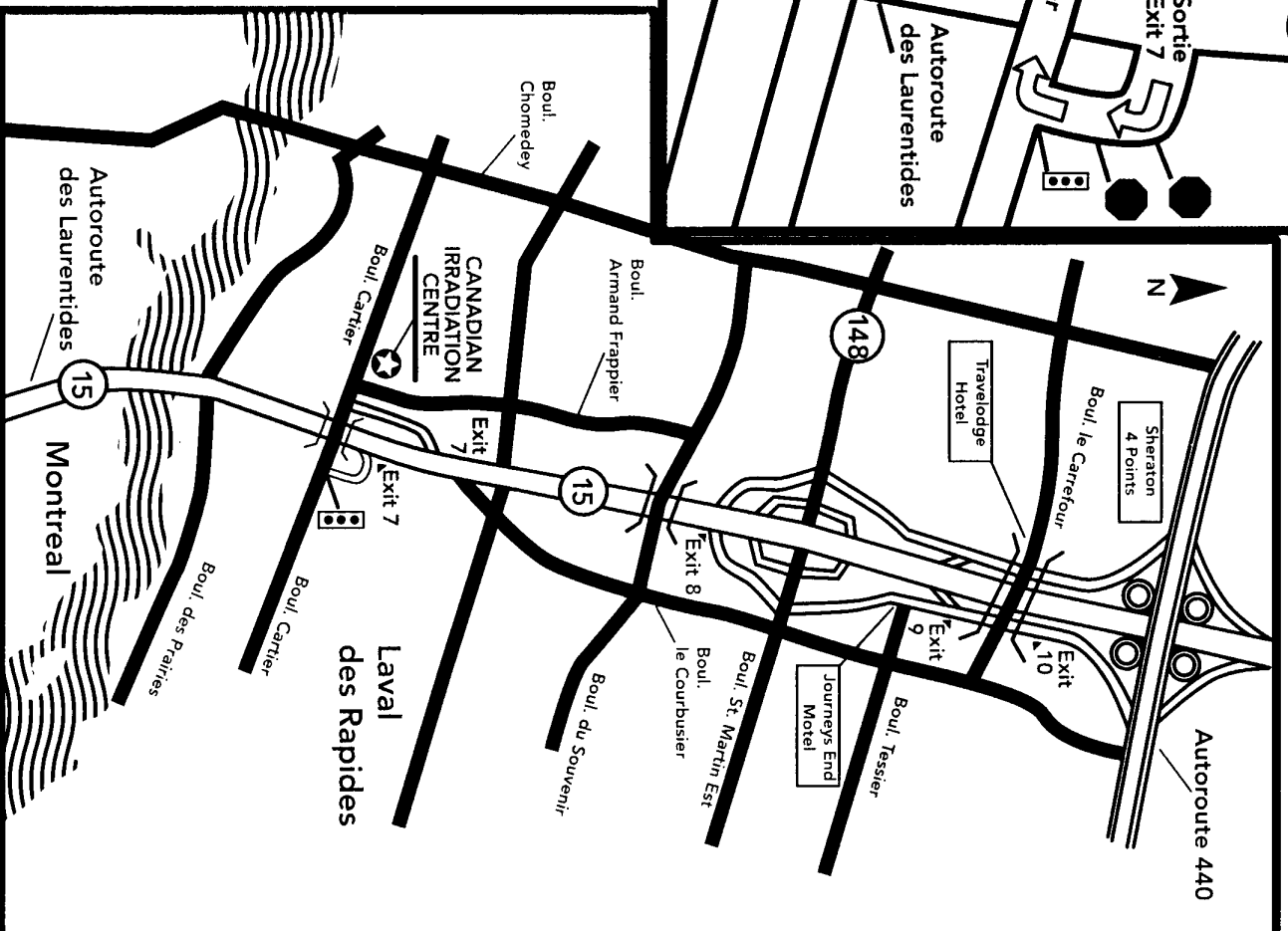
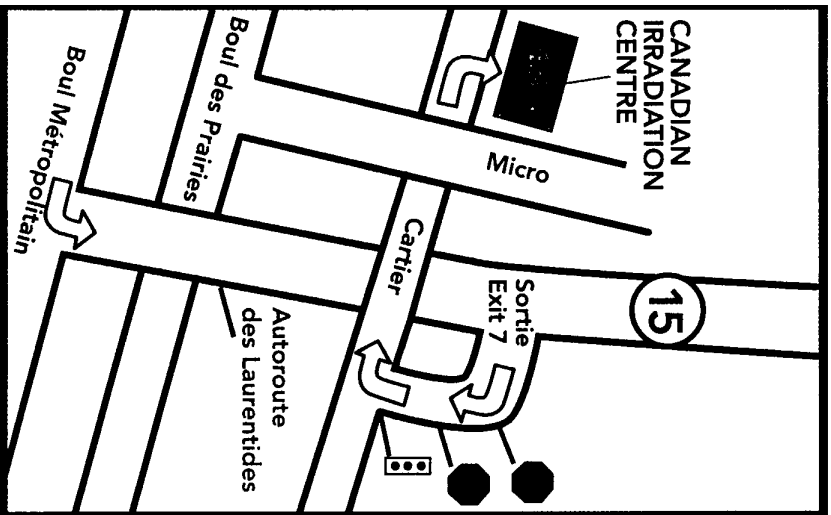


From Dorval airport take Route 520 East (Est) to Route 40 East (Est), to Route 15 North (Nord).
