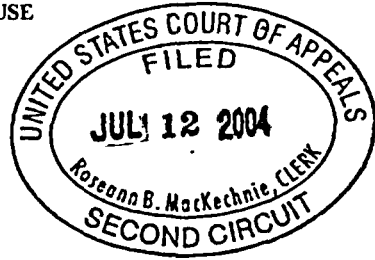

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that 10 copies of each brief shall be filed with the Clerk.


