APPLICANT: Dominion Nuclear North Anna, LLC (Dominion), System Energy Resources, Inc. (SERI), Exelon Generating Company, LLC (Exelon)

SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF SEPTEMBER 9, 2004, CATEGORY 1 MEETING WITH DOMINION, SERI, AND EXELON REGARDING REVIEWS OF EMERGENCY PLANNING ASPECTS OF THEIR RESPECTIVE EARLY SITE PERMIT (ESP) APPLICATIONS

On September 9, 2004, a public meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and representatives of Dominion, SERI, and Exelon at the NRC Headquarters in Rockville, MD. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the application-specific aspects of NRC's review of major features of emergency plans (EPs) submitted by the ESP applicants. A list of meeting attendees is included as Attachment 1. The meeting agenda is provided as Attachment 2. No documents were provided by the applicants to the staff during this meeting.

The three ESP applicants stated their concerns pertaining to: (1) the level of detail required in the ESP application to get an "acceptable" determination in regards to major features; (2) use of existing EPs in an ESP application that have an existing status of providing "reasonable assurance;" (3) approval of additional major features, beyond those specified in NUREG-0654, Supplement 2, Section V; and (4) the extent to which an "acceptable" finding for major features will provide finality in regard to the combined license (COL) application. The staff has tentatively scheduled a meeting during the week of October 18, 2004, to further discuss these issues.

SERI requested more time to respond to the staff's requests for additional information (RAIs) concerning emergency planning submitted by the NRC letter of August 13, 2004. Dominion stated that they will respond to the outstanding RAIs. Exelon stated that they will respond to the outstanding RAIs in accordance with their interpretation of the RAIs in relation to concerns (1) through (4).
