Abstract:

10 CFR Part 63 contains requirements for licensing the DOE high-level radioactive wastes geologic repository at Yucca Mountain. The information collection requirements subject to the Paperwork Reduction Act are limited to the requirement for the State of Nevada, local governments, or affected Indian tribes that wish to participate in the license application review or who request consultation the NRC staff concerning the review to submit a written request for consultation and a statement of its authority to act in such a representative capacity. Each party may also submit a proposal to facilitate its participation in the review.
