SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF SEPTEMBER 20, 2004, MEETING WITH FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY, ON STEAM GENERATOR INSPECTION PLANS FOR ST. LUCIE UNIT 2 (TAC NO. MC4084)

On September 20, 2004, a Category 1 public meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and representatives of the Florida Power and Light Company (the licensee) at NRC Headquarters, One White Flint North, 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the plans for Steam Generator (SG) inspections at St. Lucie Unit 2 during the 2004 refueling outage. A list of attendees is provided as Attachment 1.

The licensee presented the information contained in Attachment 2. The licensee reviewed the background of previous SG inspection results and presented its plans for inspections during the refueling outage that commences in November 2004.

The staff queried the licensee about various details of the presentation in order to obtain clarification, which the licensee provided. The staff indicated that it was satisfied with the plan, but might have additional questions or comments during the outage when initial inspection findings are routinely discussed by telephone.

The licensee indicated that it would be submitting a license amendment revising the SG inspection and plugging requirements in response to Generic Letter 2004-01, "Requirements for Steam Generator Tube Inspections." The proposed amendment would incorporate recommendations of a Westinghouse topical report currently in preparation. The amendment request will probably be submitted in late October 2004 and will require an expedited staff review since it needs to be issued by the end of the outage.

FPL requested the meeting, which was open to the public as stated in the meeting notice dated August 30, 2004 [ADAMS Accession No. ML042440002], but members of the public were not in attendance. Public Meeting Feedback forms were received from the meeting participants. Comments received were generally favorable. These have been forwarded to the NRR Senior Communications Analyst who will forward them to the Office of the Executive Director for Operations.
