SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF OPEN AND CLOSED MEETING BETWEEN NRC
STAFF AND THE NUCLEAR ENERGY INSTITUTE ON
TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ISSUES

On September 27, 2004, staff from the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response, Division of Nuclear Security, met with members of the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) to discuss transportation security issues. The first part of the meeting was open and involved NEI presenting its plans to submit a petition for rulemaking to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on changes to 10 CFR Part 73. NEI indicated that the proposed petition would involve transportation security regulations and would be part of a larger petition to revise Part 73 overall. NEI indicated their petition would propose a performance-based, graded-approach, to transportation security that would include shipments involving strategic special nuclear material, spent nuclear fuel, byproduct material, and waste. Additionally, NEI indicated they would look to consolidate the transportation security requirements in a single location in Part 73 to provide for greater ease of use of by licensees and the public.

The second part of the meeting was closed due to discussion of SAFEGUARDS INFORMATION relating to NRC's transportation security requirements and initiatives. A redacted summary of the closed meeting is attached [Attachment].
