**NRC UPDATE**

- Staff preparation of recommendations to the Commission before decision on rulemaking
- NAS study released March 21, 2002, staff recommendations will be informed by this report
- NUREG-1640 serial review of final ongoing -- finalized Winter 2002
- Inventory, Collective Doses, and multiple sources study ongoing
- Interest in DOE PEIS on clearance of metals

**DOE UPDATE**

- DOE is analyzing its policy for management of scrap metals
  - Scrap Metals Disposition Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (PEIS)
  - The draft document is scheduled to be released for public comment on September 27, 2002
  - A 45 day public comment period will follow during which DOE will conduct at least one public hearing
  - The final PEIS is expected to be issued in the Spring of 2003
