Back in April you all received copies of the latest draft of DS161 for comment. This is G2003-222. The instructions provided were to get comments back to OIP by 7/31/03. In light of last year's experience we need to plan on getting those comments to Carl Paperiello by that point.

Bob Meck has the lead for assembling those comments and is currently planning to meet with the ISCORS recycle sub-committee to receive their comments by July 11. He will provide them to you to look at prior to submitting our comments to Carl.
