The DS-161 version I received in your 6/26/03 email is dated March 2002. The DS-161 version sent out by Bob M via email on 2/24/03 is dated March 2003.

It's my understanding the version of the DS-161 Draft Safety Guide we are supposed to be reviewing is dated April 2003. Also, there is an April 2003 version of a Draft Safety Report, entitled "Derivation of Activity Concentration Levels of Material not Requiring Regulation," that provides the technical basis and scenarios for the DS-161 values.

Back in April you all received copies of the latest draft of DS161 for comment. This is G2003-222. The instructions provided were to get comments back to OIP by 7/31/03. In light of last year's experience we need to plan on getting those comments to Carl Paperiello by that point.

Bob Meck has the lead for assembling those comments and is currently planning to meet with the ISCORS recycle sub-committee to receive their comments by July 11. He will provide them to you to look at prior to submitting our comments to Carl. It is important that we do review this draft and provide the necessary feedback to support Carl and John in their RASSC and WASSC roles. The version sent out in April is attached.

We will need to get a final set of comments to Carl by 7/31 in order to meet the date expected to IAEA. Please provide any comments you have on the document by 7/25 at the latest - earlier would be preferred.
