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Dear Ms. Weidner:

This letter is in response to your letter dated July 8, 2004, in reference to Allegheny General Hospital (AGH), NRC Licence Number 37-01317-01, docket No. 030-02981, Control No. 134840.

As stated in the January 20, 1995-letter, the 3290 William Pitt Way facility, known as UPARC, was actually located in Suite 125 of Building 9. All other radioactive material labs are located at 320 East North Ave. or the 1307 Federal St. locations.

The UPARC facility was a single floor with several rooms, see an attached floor plan. AGH occupied no other locations at that site. Researchers at UPARC used trace amounts of C-14, H-3 and P-32. Contamination surveys were performed weekly and exposure surveys were performed after each day radioactive material was used. Final exposure and contamination surveys were performed on November 27, 1998, after all material was removed from the site. The surveys were provided in the July 8, 2004-letter. Those surveys indicate there was no residual contamination. The lease was dissolved and AGH has no other interests at that site.
