Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552 (as amended), the NATIONAL TREASURY EMPLOYEES UNION hereby requests the following information:

Any and all reports, studies, analyses, evaluations, or other informational documents that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission may have contributed, developed, or created concerning the Partnership for Public Service and the Institute for the Study of Public Policy Implementation's study entitled "The Best Places to Work in the Federal Government."

In fulfilling this FOIA request, NTEU prefers that the data be furnished in electronic format on either 3½-inch computer diskettes or compact discs.

If all or any part of this request is denied, please list the specific exemption(s) that is/are being claimed to withhold the information. In addition, should you determine that some portions of the requested material are exempt, I expect, as the Act provides, that you will provide me with the remaining non-exempt portions. In addition, please provide me an estimate of the volume of the requested information that is being withheld or denied.

According to the Act, a waiver of fees based on service in the public interest is requested because the aforementioned information will likely assist us in better serving the interests of the NATIONAL TREASURY EMPLOYEES UNION'S numerous bargaining units employees by further contributing to their overall understanding of Government operations. Furthermore, a waiver should be granted due to the fact that this request is not in NTEU's commercial interest.

In the event that the request for a waiver of all fees is denied, NTEU is willing to pay up to a maximum of one hundred U.S. dollars (\$100.00). If you anticipate that the fees will exceed this monetary limit, please notify me in writing.
